Course Description

Transanal Minimally Invasive Surgery (TAMIS) allows local excision of benign and malignant polyps from the rectum, through the use of advanced access devices and laparoscopic instruments.

Who Can Join The Course?

This one-day course is designed for advanced Colorectal Surgeons who wish to set up TAMIS in their unit, under the guidance of an MDT. Training will be on the GelPOINT® path transanal access platform.

About The Course

The course will include a didactic session (on May 13th, 2022) and a hands-on workshop on May 14th OR May 15th, 2022, based on surgeon preference and availability of slots between the 2 days. Participants will gain a comprehensive understanding of TAMIS procedural techniques and instrumentation.
